Job Purpose

Lincoln City Foundation uses the appeal of the Premier League and Lincoln City Football Club to inspire children to learn to be active and develop important life skills.

The role will co-ordinate all the delivery aspects of the Premier League Primary Stars programme, Schools contracts including all programmes delivered in schools within partner schools. The aim of the position is to contribute to the development of a quality PE and School Sport offer to pupils between the ages of 4 – 16 in Lincoln and Lincolnshire.

In line with Foundation and Premier League Objectives we will:

- Work in partnership to drive up standards in PE across our target Primary Schools, both through the intensive offer and our football offer. We will do this by responding to needs of individual schools working through the School PE Coordinator, where they are in post, or and directly with the teaching staff.
- Provide a responsive offer that meets the needs of schools across PE, Health, PSHE and Literacy by building genuine partnerships with schools to ensure we meet their need.
- Build strategic partnerships in key areas of the city and to work more closely in partnership, with our SSPAN, CSP and County FA where we have the same objectives and target groups.

Key Responsibilities

Main responsibilities of the role include:

- Deliver a high-quality school offer to include curriculum, extra-curricular, targeted interventions and collapsed curriculum days that meet the needs of partner schools.
- Support the professional development of teaching staff, which builds skills and confidence to deliver high quality PE.

- To develop positive working relationships with schools and ensure the Foundation secures existing and new contracts each year.
- To implement the Premier League Primary Stars programme, meeting all pre requisites of the Premier League Charitable Fund grant conditions.
- Expand our delivery of After School Clubs using both models of delivery plus recruit an appropriately qualified workforce to manage and deliver.
- Continue to develop the Fuel for School programme by engaging new schools to expand the programme and create a greater impact locally
- To develop strong relationships between Lincoln City Foundation and partner schools. To include external partners County FA, SSPAN and CSP.
- Action quality assurance procedures for all project aspects.
- To monitor the progress of the project to ensure all data is accurate, appropriately managed and inputted using the online monitoring tool VIEWS, working towards all KPIs being achieved.
- Support the ongoing development of PL Primary Stars lesson resources with the Education Manager and Lead Coach.
- Report, record and resolve any issues with the Education Manager.
- Complete all internal and external monitoring reports in a timely manner to a high standard with detail and accuracy.
- To oversee, co-ordinate and support the development of Community Sports Coaches.
- Attend any training to develop relevant knowledge and skills.
- To represent the Foundation, when required, at internal and external meetings.
